Baker Arts Center: An interactive art gallery and studio in Liberal, showcasing new and permanent exhibits, provides classes for all ages.

Benincasa Hospitality House: A ministry of St. Catherine Hospital that houses families of patients experiencing extended hospital stays.

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Finney & Kearny Counties: One-to-one mentoring programs for at-risk youth ages 5-17.

Camp Lakeside: United Methodist camp offering programs for children and youth at Scott Lake State Park.

Catholic Charities of SW KS: Provides human services support through counseling, economic assistance, immigration advocacy, and more.

Cerebral Palsy Research Foundation: Provides specialized services for people with all types of disabilities.

Chains Break: Tattoo removal service to assist individuals exit oppressive systems.

Community Mexican Fiesta of Garden City: Celebrates Mexican culture through scholarships, parade, folkloric dancing, and food.

Emmaus House: Serves as a homeless shelter, food pantry and soup kitchen.

Family Crisis Services: Provides support services to survivors of domestic abuse.

Finney County 4-H Foundation: Supports youth development through scholarships and programs.

Finney County Historical Society: Preserves the past to enlighten the future through exhibits and programs.

Finney County Humane Society: Prevents animal cruelty and provide shelter, medical care, and adoptions services to local animals.

Finney County Preservation Alliance: Preserves historic community structures, primarily the Windsor Hotel.

Finney County Public Library: Offers over 124,000 items to the community and hosts educational events and programs.
